**Notice of Race for RG65 National Championship 2016 to be held
at Princes Park, Eastbourne on Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th June 2016
Host Club: Eastbourne and District Model Yacht Club**

1. Event Schedule.

Friday 3rd June - Registration at EDMYC clubhouse from 4pm – 6pm.

Saturday 4th June - Registration at EDMYC clubhouse from 8.00am – 9.30am
Briefing at 09.45 hours. Racing will commence not less than 15 minutes
following Briefing. No race will start after 17.00 hours.

Sunday 5th June. Briefing at 09.15 hours. Racing will commence not less than 15
minutes following briefing. No race will start after 15.30hours. Any race in progress
at 16.30 hours will be abandoned.

2. **Location.** Princes Park, Wartling Road, Eastbourne BN22 7PR.

3. Entry and Eligibility

Entry is open to all members of MYA affiliated Clubs and to members of foreign
clubs affiliated to a Delegated National Member of IRSA. [Enter using the on
line entry form](#). Entry for UK competitors opens from **Monday 28th March 2016**.
Non UK competitors may enter on or after Monday 4th April 2016. Closing date
for entries is **Friday 27th May 2016**. After the closing date late entries may be
accepted at the discretion of the organising club and may incur an additional
late entry fee.

All boats must be registered with, and display a sail number issued by the
RG65 UK Class Association.

4. **Entry Fees** - Event entry fee is £20. This can be paid by the following methods:-

Please ensure that your name is included in the payment reference.

Entry into this event is only confirmed by receipt of payment in advance.

5. **Sailing Instructions** – The event will be governed by:-

- Racing Rules of Sailing as amended by RRS Appendix E
- Equipment Rules of Sailing
- MYA Regulations for the Organisation of National Championships
- MYA Standard Sailing Instructions
- RG 65 International Class Rules (<http://www.rg65.org.uk/rules>)
- HMS 2016.

The Race Officer reserves the right to use observers drawn from the competitors.

A protest committee will be appointed by the Race Committee to hear any protests arising from the event and will comprise of competitors not involved in the relevant heat in which the incident is alleged to have occurred.

Dragon Force 65's will be allowed to display 3 digit sail numbers.

Measurement – The race committee may at any time during the event measure any boat or rig to ensure compliance with the RG65 International Class Rules.

6. Entry List, Sail Numbers and Frequency Allocation. Will be displayed on the race management notice board and the club website NOR page for this event. Competitors will be notified of necessary changes in the event of a clash of sail numbers.

7. Accommodation. Follow this link - www.visiteastbourne.com

8. Parking. Off road parking is available within Princes Park, weather permitting, however, there is no provision for those wishing to stay overnight (caravans/campervans). On road parking is available on Wartling Road. Club stewards will be at the entrance to Princes Park at the junction of Wartling/Winchelsea Roads to direct competitors into the parking area on both days.

8. Refreshments - Hot and cold refreshments will be available throughout both of the days at the clubhouse.

9. General Information. Princes Park Lake is a salt water venue, a fresh water hose will be provided to wash off yachts. Competitors are encouraged to use hand washing facilities provided. Yachts and equipment may be stored overnight in the clubhouse at the owners risk. The clubhouse will be locked and alarmed.

10. The clubhouse and lake will be available for practice between 14.00 hours and 18.00 hours on Fri 3 June.

There will be a Social event (Buffet or BBQ yet to be decided) at Eastbourne United FC Oval Bar from 19.00hrs to 2330hrs Saturday 4th June. Entry for competitors is free, non-competitors are welcome at a cost to be confirmed payable at the door. Please indicate if you will be bringing a partner or number of guests in order to assist with catering plans.
